



BASIC BUILDING TYPES

Apartment - a self-contained housing unit that occupies only part of a building.

Barn - a building used to store farm products and shelter livestock.

City Hall - building that houses administrative offices of a municipal government.

Civic - relating or belonging to citizens.

Church - place for public (especially Christian) worship.

Commercial - connected with commerce or commercial enterprises.

County Courthouse – seat of county government and home of local courts.

Factory - a place where goods are manufactured.

Home - where you live at a particular time.

Hospital - medical institution where sick or injured people are given medical or surgical care.

Hotel - building where travelers can pay for lodging and meals and other services.

House - dwelling that serves as living quarters for one or more families.

Mosque – a Muslim house of worship.

Library - building that houses a collection of books and other materials.

Lumber Mill - sawmill that produces lumber.

Mixed Use - property type with two or more harmonious uses, such as a building with retail shops on lower floors and apartments on upper floors.

Multi-Family - building that is designed to house more than one family.

Office - place of business where professional or clerical duties are performed.

Residence - any address at which you dwell more than temporarily.

Shipyards – a place where ships are built, repaired and outfitted.

School - a building where people receive education.

Seafood Factory - factory for processing and packaging seafood.

Store - a mercantile establishment for the retail sale of goods or services.

Synagogue - the place of worship for a Jewish congregation.

Theatre - building where theatrical performances or motion-picture shows can be presented.

Train Station - terminal where trains load or unload passengers or goods.

Warehouse - storehouse for goods and merchandise.
