Old State Capitol Ornament and Note Card Sets

Old State Capitol Ornament - \$15

This limited edition pewter ornament features the Old State Capitol in Jackson which served as the Mississippi seat of government from 1839 to 1903. The ornament is 2 inches wide by 1 inch tall and can be used as an ornament or worn on a necklace or as a pin. A brief history of the building is included with the ornament, which comes in a sealed package.

Mississippi's 10 Most Endangered Places Note Cards - \$10

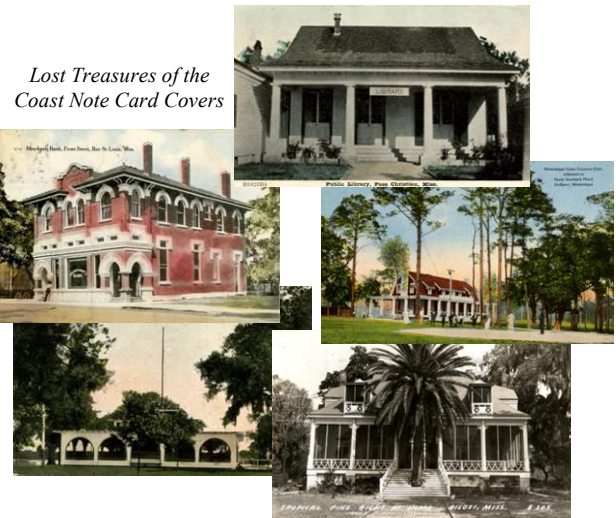

Information about each site is printed on the back side of the card. Cards are 3 ½ by 5 ½ inches and come with envelopes.

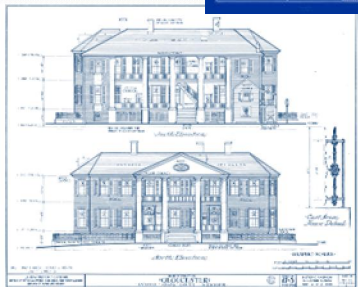
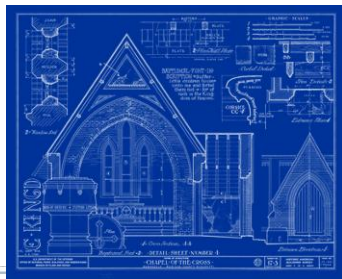
Lost Treasures of the Mississippi Coast Note Cards - \$10

The *Lost Treasures* note cards are reproductions of historic postcards of sites from the Mississippi Coast that were lost during Hurricane Katrina in 2005. Two images of each of the following sites are included in each pack of note cards: Old Pass Christian Library, Merchants Bank - Bay St. Louis, Great Southern Golf and Country Club - Gulfport, Anderson Park Pavilion - Pascagoula, and the Father Ryan House - Biloxi. Information about each site is printed on the back side of the card. Cards are 3 ½ by 5 ½ inches and come with envelopes.

Historic American Building Survey (HABS) Note Cards - \$12

The *HABS* note cards features images of architectural drawings from the Historic American Building Survey which began in 1933 to document important buildings across the U.S. In this set are twelve images including: Warren County Courthouse, Manship House - Jackson, Shamrock - Vicksburg, 'Old French Fort' - Pascagoula, Butler Dogtrot - Tishomingo County, Rosalie - Natchez, Sullivan House - Ocean Springs, Chapel of the Cross - Mannsdale, The Gillis House - Biloxi, Aberdeen Station - Aberdeen, Gloucester - Natchez, and the Pleasant Reed House - Biloxi. Information about each site is printed on the back side of the card. Cards are 5 by 7 inches and come with envelopes in a gift box with clear cover.
