




## **Brumfield Apartments**Photo courtesy of Mississippi Heritage Trust

Built in 1905, this old post office was converted into an African American History Museum in the late 1990s.











This 1924 hospital was converted into a battered women's shelter and transitional housing in the early 1990s.







Erected in 1907 as the county jail, this brick structure was built in the Romanesque style of architecture. It was used as a place of incarceration for seventy years before being abandoned. In 1984, it was completely renovated and now serves as the county library.
